Lucy never set out wanting a role in audit. After studying architecture at university, Lucy spent 15 months working at an architecture practice.

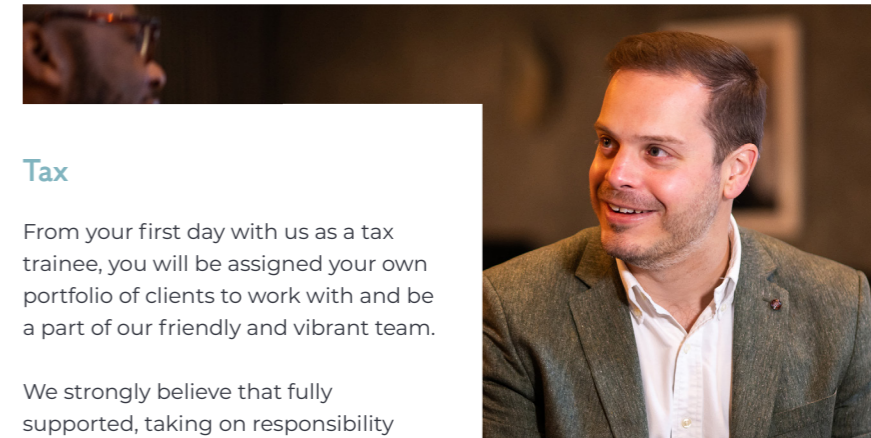
